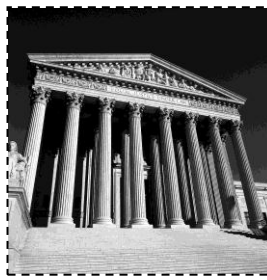

Journal and Article Requirements

Each week a journal and article are due.

Articles/Journal assignments are online each week and are to be turned in no later than Monday or the first day of the following week. If you know you are going to be gone on Monday, turn in the end of the week they are assigned.

The journal and article count as test points and will help you if you complete the assignments. In addition an extra credit assignment will be due. Extra credit pts are only given if both the article and journal assignments are completed. Extra credit is encouraged to counteract missed work, poor test scores, etc. No late work will be accepted.

NOTE: Article/Journal and Extra Credit must be stapled and turned in together weekly.

Articles

Articles are worth 10 pts. or more.

In order to get full pts article sheets must be filled out fully and completely.

Nothing skipped. Articles must be attached to the back of the sheet. If using the internet for articles, the article must be within the past month.

Extra Credit-

Extra Credit will be offered each week if the journal and article is turned in with it.

Extra Credit will be given a maximum pt. total and the quality of the extra credit will determine the pt. total earned.

Daily journaling/Reflections journal (Ongoing Final)
